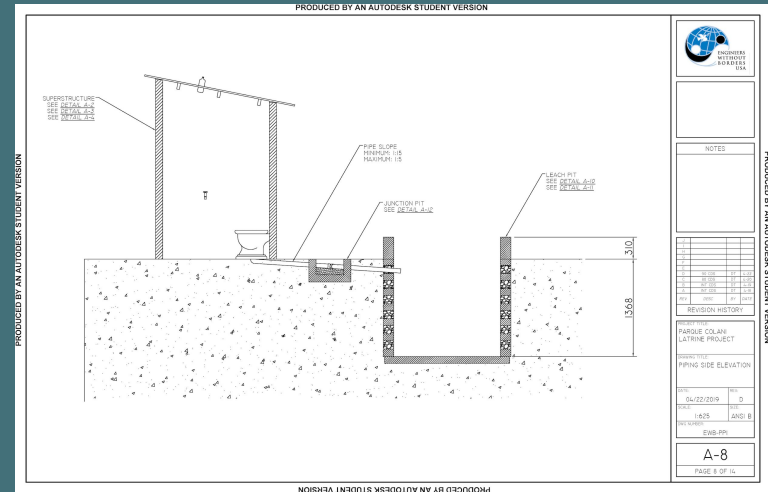
# Implementation

## Project Scope:

- Design/Build 25 sustainable latrines
- Advocate on proper hygiene practices

## Project Design:

- Twin-pit composting latrine
  - Includes: shower space & hand-washing station







## Past Work

### 2019: Travel trip

- Built community latrine
- Distributed re-usable female hygiene kits

### 2020/2021: Remote work

- Built 1 household latrine (Fall 2020)
- COVID/food relief effort (April 2021)





# Bolivia Subteams

- Construction
  - Make material calculations, edit and create construction/maintenance manuals
- Project Inspectors
  - Inspect daily construction photos during remote implementation, ensure construction follows our design
- Communication
  - Frequent communication with construction manager and community members, translate documents
- Budget
  - Estimate cost of materials, organize payments, apply for grants
- Education/Cultural
  - Create hygiene lesson plans for community, share current events and Bolivian culture with team



# Future Plans

- Build remaining latrines (some remotely)
- Maintenance/construction manuals
- Creating more hygiene lesson plans
- Strengthen relationship with the community
